


Plan for Mastery for AP Biology.


One of my 3 goals for this course is that you Master Biology and prepare for the AP Exam. For any test that you do not score at least 80%, complete the following remediation plan and **turn in within 1 week** of receiving your graded test. **LATE Tests will not be accepted and will earn a ZERO mastery grade.**

- ✓ Launch your Campbell's 8th Edition CD
- ✓ Open a Chapter. In the left hand "study area" Highlight and proceed to the cumulative test.
- ✓ Select the chapters that the test covered. Remember each test is cumulative, so you will need to select all the chapters that we have learned up to that test.




- ✓ Choose **30 questions** and start the test.

You may look up answers to questions in your book or other resources. Note that the program will keep a record of questions that you request an online hint for/do not get correct the first time.



On one sheet of paper, print (using the Print Screen function, copy and paste to a word document) 2 things: the **window with "Question 30 of 30"** and **"Answer Summary"** with your score. You need at least **90% correct** on the **1st try** to earn credit for this assignment. You may take the test as many times as you like. When you print the screen, print the ENTIRE COMPUTER SCREEN not just the Campbell's Test screen.
